It is important that you mail all parts of the application together in one package (application, references, transcript, and essay). For each of the references, we ask that they sign their name across the sealed/closed flap of each envelope. We will not be able to accept incomplete applications.

Finalists will be contacted to schedule an interview. All applicants of the scholarship will be sent a letter in regards to their status. The scholarship will be applied towards your next semester's tuition.
